ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, 10% of Management Quota seats in each branch under the engineering colleges of CAPE were reserved exclusively for children of employees working in Co-operative Sector/Institutions to which Registrar of Co-operative Society is the controlling authority by statute. The 162nd Executive Committee meeting of CAPE held on 20.03.2018 has resolved to include the wards of the Director Board members of the Co-operative Society/Banks/Institutions to which Registrar of Co-operative Society is the controlling authority and wards of employees of the Co-operation Department in the 10% reservation earmarked under management quota as per Order read as 1st paper above. The Executive Committee has also resolved to introduce a scholarship of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) per year from the academic year 2018-19 onwards to the students who are admitted under this reservation scheme.

2) As per letter read as 2nd paper above Director, CAPE requested to include the wards of the Director Board members of the Co-operative Society/Banks/Institutions to which Registrar of Co-operative Society is the controlling authority and wards of the employees of Co-operation Department in the 10% reservation earmarked under management quota sanctioned as per GO(Rt)No. 29/2017/Co-op dated 18.01.2017 by filling up the seats through the allotment process of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and to introduce a scholarship of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) per year during the academic year 2018-19 onwards to the students who will be admitted under this reservation scheme.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to include the wards of the Director Board members of the Co-operative Society/Banks/Institutions to which Registrar of Co-operative Society is the controlling authority and wards of employees of the Co-operation Department in the 10% reservation earmarked under management quota sanctioned as per GO(Rt)No.29/2017/Co-op dated 18.01.2017 by filling up the seats through the allotment process of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. It is also ordered to introduce a scholarship of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) per year during the academic year 2018-19 onwards to the students who will be admitted under this reservation scheme.
